- 1. Academy Giving: Jackie Curtis
- Snowstorm transitioning to "Great-ful Hearts" Campaign
- Trend shows that December's Snowstorm campaign has impacted tax credit giving at Archway and Prep; main "ask" for tax credit moneys occurs in December and are earmarked to support extracurriculars
- Suggested: Great-ful Hearts Luncheon still be scheduled for December; collect funds in November
- Family giving "asks" by Academy Giving
 - o Capital campaign contributions ongoing for 5-year plan @ North Phoenix
 - Tax credit (all)
 - Community investment (all)
 - Teachers Excellence Fund (targeted)
- Teachers Excellence Fund
 - New program at Great Hearts that is geared to retain/recognize teachers who have served
 3+ years; encourage retention
 - 70% stays at school; 30% to general fund of entire network (some schools will be already working on capital campaigns)
 - o Targeted "ask" to families who give to community investment
 - o Bonus structure based on tenure
 - Partners with Leadership Society for continuing education and international travel
 - To be distributed every October (moneys collected July June)

2. Committee Updates

Lunch Program

- Lunch program begins Monday, August 13
- Costs increased on many items from vendors so prices were adjusted accordingly
- Current menu cycle: August 13 October 5
- Parents may order for the entire cycle or weekly; weekly cut-off for ordering stays at 12 pm the
 Friday before the week of service
- Cane's discontinued the 2-piece combo (our biggest seller) and only offered a 3-piece combo; we
 will not be offering Cane's this cycle
- Added an additional Chick-fil-A day on Fridays along with Firehouse Subs
- New menu items include: chow mein by Panda Express, grilled chicken by Chick-fil-A, chocolate milk by Smoothie King

Field trip dates are not available yet, so days have not yet been blocked from menu cycle
