- A. Ms. Parker welcomed the group, thanked the PSO Board, and introduced President LaShon Bryant.

 - 4. Jessica Sprinkle Secretary Newsletter 6th grader, Campus Coordinator for Atheneum
 - 5. Lots of other community members as Chairs of other departments and helping in other ways
 - 6. PSO working on plans to tie in the DL group with the on-campus group to keep our Community tight
- C. Walter Health of the PSO. Money Collected, where it goes i.e. Teacher Appreciation, Movie Night etc.
 - 1. Operates on fiscal year 7/1-6/30
 - 2. 1st Quarter report: have a little over \$10K in our operating fund
 - Goal of PSO is to support scholars and teachers (not make money) 2 biggest programs are Hot Lunch Program & Used Uniform Sale
 - 1. Brought in about \$4400 in income from Hot Lunch Program and have paid out about \$2100 (due to prepaid lunches for the semester) we usually net <10% when all the numbers are in
 - 2. Brought in >\$4000 from used uniform sale, spirit day wear, and masks
 - 4. Teacher Appreciation provide teachers with snacks, goodies, luncheon, etc. Spent about \$700 in September for these things
 - 5. Tom Hughes did ask question he is scheduled to do teacher appreciation in October and wants to know how early he can bring in food

 Answer: Touch base with Berenice – she will help make this happen
